AJPID Article Submission Guidelines

The Australian Journal of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry aims to promote the field of Periodontics and Implant Dentistry through clinical papers, original research, review articles, case reports and other correspondence that the Editor thinks appropriate to print. Submissions of articles covering these areas are welcomed.

Contributions should be submitted in electronic form in Microsoft Word by e-mail to the editor. The contribution should be prepared with double spacing and 2.5cm margins. A letter signed by all its authors must accompany an article. The author's name should appear under the title and the full postal address at the end of the text.

Clinical and original research papers should be clearly divided into Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion. All manuscripts will be sent to a reviewer for assessment.

Tables, figures, photographs and radiographs should be submitted either contained in the Word file or in separately clearly labelled files.

References should be set out in the Uniform Requirement (Vancouver) style. Identify references in the text, tables and legends by the first author's name and the year of publication, in parentheses. A list of references should be provided in alphabetical order at the end of the manuscript.

If the reported research involves either human or animal experimentation then the authors must indicate that the ethical guidelines of the Australian National Health and Medical Research Council or the Declaration of Helsinki have been applied. If the research involves human subjects then the authors must state that informed consent was obtained.

Material is received on the understanding that it may be subject to Editorial revision and that, on acceptance, becomes the property of the Australian Journal of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry. All expressions of opinion or statements of supposed facts are those of the authors and are not to be regarded as the views of the ASP/AOS or Editorial Board of Australian Journal of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry.
